

I chose UCO because it was close to home and I wasn't ready for a big university. Visiting on Open Days reassured me, smaller classes and extra support were exactly what I needed.

One of my highlights was accessing Student Support, where I got a dyslexia assessment. It completely changed how I learned, and tutors knew how to support me. I also chose my own placements, which gave me the freedom to explore safeguarding and mental health work.

Careers helped me with CVs and job hunting, even after I graduated.

Now I'm a Programme Co-ordinator at Greater Manchester Youth Network and a Mental Health First Aider. UCO gave me the skills and confidence to get here.

I was drawn to UCO for its unique strengths, particularly the personalised support and smaller class sizes. Financial support

We'll help you to make sense of tuition fees, maintenance loans, grants and funding options.

Most students apply for a Tuition Fee Loan and a Maintenance Loan to support their studies and living costs. Depending on your circumstances, you might also be eligible for additional support such as a Childcare Grant or Disabled Students' Allowance.

While we don't offer onsite accommodation, our Student Services team can offer guidance on local housing options for living independently.

Qualifications explained

Choose from a wide range of courses to suit your goals, from foundation degrees to post-graduate courses and professional qualifications.

Choose a qualification that works for you.

- Bachelor of Arts or Science Degrees with Honours (BA/BSc)
 - A full degree recognised in the UK and Europe. Usually takes three years to complete full-time.
- Foundation Degrees in Arts or Science (FdA/FdSc)
 - A level 5 qualification, equal to the first two years of a degree. Combines workbased learning with academic study.
- Higher National Certificate and Diploma (HNC/HND)

Respected by employers and more practical than a traditional degree, these qualifications offer direct career pathways.



- Higher Technical Qualifications (HTQ)
 These are level 4 and 5 qualifications, such as Foundation Degrees, HNCs and HNDs that have been approved against employer developed standards and provide the skills
- needed for your career.Master's Degrees (MA)

A Master's is a level 7 course you can take after finishing your degree. It lets you explore a subject in more depth and can help you get ahead in your career.

• Professional Diplomas

These are practical courses that focus on skills for a specific job or industry.

- Teacher Education Programmes
 Courses to help you qualify as a teacher
 advance your teaching career with
 - or advance your teaching career, with routes for both new and experienced professionals.
- Top Up Degrees (Hons)
 Add one final year to your HND or
 Foundation Degree to earn a full Honours
 Degree.
